



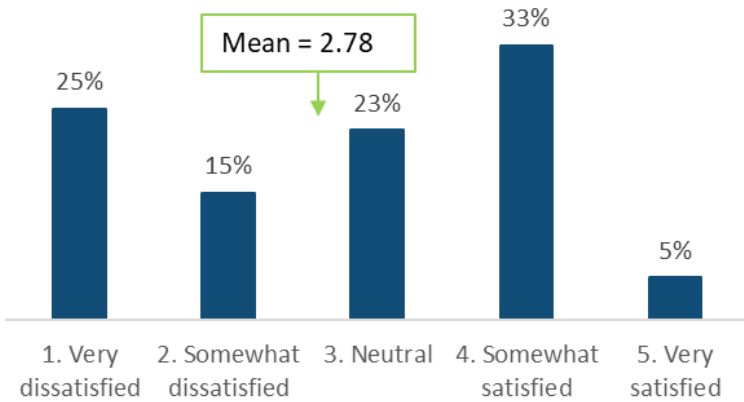

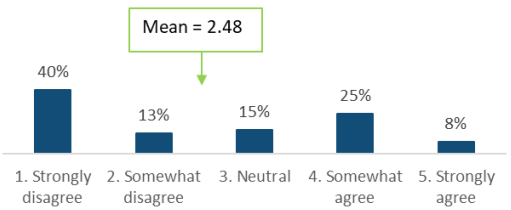

How satisfied were you with the apology from the Pope to the Indigenous People of Canada?



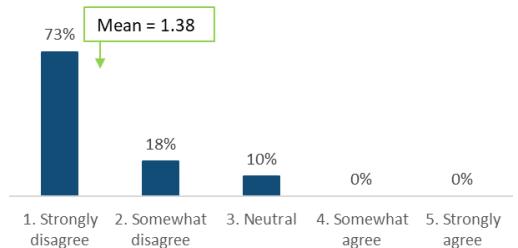
To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement:

To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement:

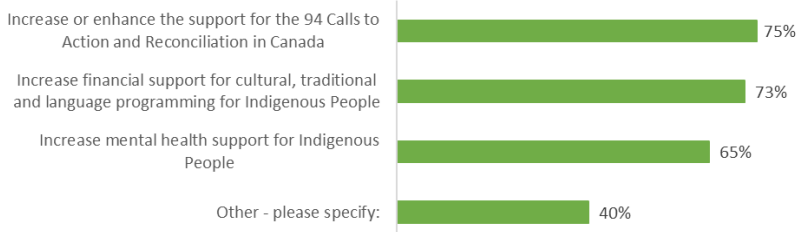
The Catholic Church is doing enough for the Indigenous People of Canada for the wrongdoings they inflicted.



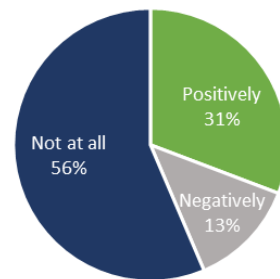
What does this apology mean to you? Please select all that apply.
